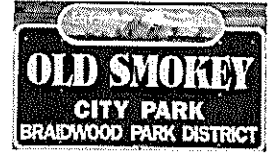



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Braidwood Park District, Will County, Illinois in regular session assembled:

The President and Board of Commissioners of the Braidwood Park District hereby declare that they would have passed the remaining parts of the Ordinance if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
