

The Meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m. by President Howard

Roll was called finding the following board members to be physically present: Howard, Grivetti, Bolatto and Hopf.

The following board members were absent: Kaminsky

Public Comment: Public Comment was opened by President Howard at 2:01pm. There being no comment, Public Comment was closed at 2:02p.m.

New and Unfinished Business:

- Comm. Bolatto presented information on Ordinance #26-02; 2025-2026 Tax Levy. Comm. Bolatto stated that the levy was placed on file for public inspection as required. A motion was made by Comm. Bolatto, 2nd by Comm. Grivetti to approve Ordinance 25-02, FY2024-2025 Tax Levy as presented.
Roll Call: Howard – Yes, Grivetti – Yes, Bolatto – Yes, Hopf - Yes.
Motion Carried. (4-Yes, 0-No, 1-Absent)

- Comm. Bolatto presented the insurance renewal proposal and invoice from IPARKS. A motion was made by Commissioner Bolatto, 2nd by Commissioner Hopf to approve renewal of the district's insurance policy with IPARKS in the amount of \$20,034.00.

Motion Carried. (4-Yes, 0-No, 1-Absent)

- Comm. Bolatto stated that the City of Braidwood has been able to negotiate with Hitchcock Design Group to reduce the cost of the Master Parks Plan to \$25,000.00. The City has inquired if the District would be willing to cover \$5,000.00 of the cost instead of \$2,500.00 which the board has previously approved. The payment would be broken down into two installments, with the first being paid in the current fiscal year, and the second being paid in June of 2026. A motion was made by Commissioner Grivetti, 2nd by Commissioner Bolatto to increase the district's contribution to the Master Parks Plan to \$5,000.00.

ORDINANCE #26-02

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE BRAIDWOOD PARK DISTRICT, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2025 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Braidwood Park District, Will County, Illinois in regular session assembled:

SECTION 1: The sum of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$170,300.00) be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon and against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Braidwood Park District as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for 2025. The said taxes which are hereby levied are exclusive of the amounts previously levied for the payment of bonded indebtedness and interest thereon.

SECTION 2: That the sum of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$170,300.00) is levied and assessed from the following listed items; that the amount or part of each item hereby levied to be raised by taxation is set forth and described under the column headed: "TO BE RAISED BY TAXATION"; that the amount or portion to be raised by taxation is the sum of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$170,300.00).

SECTION 3: Pursuant to Section 4-4 of the Park District Code (70 ILCS 1205/4-4), neither the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the District for the current fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025 and ending April 30, 2026, nor any other Budget and Appropriation Ordinance is intended or required to be in support of the tax levy made in this ordinance.

SECTION 4: The unexpended balance of any item or items levied in and by this ordinance may be expended in making up any deficit of any item or items in the same general appropriation and levy made by this ordinance. The unexpended balance of the tax for general corporate purposes from the preceding year may be accumulated and set aside for the purposes of building repairs and improvements in a capital improvement fund, provided that the balance of such fund does not exceed 1.5% of the aggregated assessed valuation of all taxable property within the District.

SECTION 5: That forthwith upon the passage of this ordinance the Secretary of this Board is directed to file in the office of the County Clerk of Will County, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance properly certified by said Secretary as to its enactment accompanied by the certificate of the presiding officer as to compliance with the Truth in Taxation Law, and said county clerk is hereby directed to extend taxes sufficient to produce the amounts levied herein in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 6: That, if any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The President and Board of Commissioners of the Braidwood Park District hereby declare that they would have passed the remaining parts of the Ordinance if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.


SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption as required by law.




CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH TRUTH IN TAXATION






